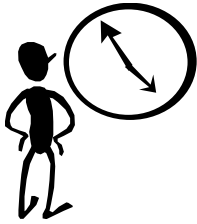

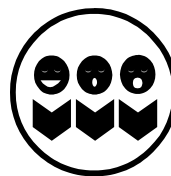

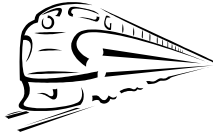
CANTATA PLANNED
