## SEPTEMBER SESSION NOTES

The Session and Trustees met on Thursday, September 19th. The meeting was opened with scripture and prayer by Moderator Kari Jutila of the Westminster Presbyterian Church of Casselton who has been assigned as our moderator while we are without a pastor.

The trustees reported on the boiler project, and at this time, we have received \$7,000. Dixon Moorhead will present information to the congregation at the Sept. 22 worship service.

Robert and Cassie Brostrom have requested that their membership be transferred to Cormorant Lutheran Church of Lake Park, Minnesota. They have a home on Lake Cormorant. This request was approved.

A request from Ruby Hendrickson to transfer from First Presbyterian of Fargo to Community Presbyterian was approved, and a request will be sent to First Presbyterian to have her membership transferred.

No Youth Director has been found at this time. Also no Choir Director had been hired so far. Dawn Larson is substituting until a director can be found.

Because First Presbyterian Church in Fargo is undergoing remodeling, some of the weddings from there will be performed at Community Presbyterian. The Session is requesting that any of

our members who plan weddings in the next year make their reservations as soon as possible so that the dates they want will be available.

Several items pertaining to the smooth running of the church were considered.

The Session voted to sponsor a Potluck on Sunday, October 20th after worship.

The Worship Committee was granted permission to put up a sign in the parking lot no more than once a month to advertise special events coming up at the church.



Andrew Thostenson is going to make arrangements to offer the 2 1/2 hours workshop prepared by the Presbytery on "What it is to be a Presbyterian." More information about this will be made prior to offering the workshop.

The Session will review the Membership Rolls at the October meeting and send letters to those members who have not been attending or supporting the church in any way. This must be done before these members can be moved to the Inactive List. Some members are unable to attend due to health reasons and the Session will take this into consideration. For each member we have we must pay Per Capita dues of approximately \$25.00 per year. This takes a large portion of our income when we have members who are not contributing to the church in anyway.

## WEST FEST REVISITED

Community Presbyterian Church was all abuzz on Saturday, September 21st as youth and adults prepared for West Fest activities. First, there was a float to decorate; later, there were children to dress up and paint for a clown extravaganza. Then, there was food to prepare. Thanks to the over twenty youth and adults who shared their time in decorating the float and clowns along with those who actually rode or walked in the parade.

The West Fest Cook-Out earned \$380 which went to the boiler fund. Thanks to all who loaned their grills, coolers, and their time to help make this possible.

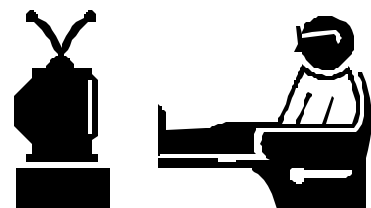
